



Policies & procedures

Reservations

Authorized patrons may make reservations up to 12 months in advance by calling Great Pond Outdoor Adventure Center at 207-584-2000 or go online: <http://www.dodlodging.net>

Reservations are based on a daily rate schedule, minimum two night stay. Authorized patrons include active duty, retirees, reservist, DoD civilians, 100 percent disabled vets and National Guard.

Check In/Check Out

Check in is 3 p.m. Check out is 11 a.m.

Late check out will be charged an additional days fee after 11 a.m.

When booking weekends, you must book for both Friday and Saturday.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellations made less than 30 days of reservation will be charged for a one night stay.

Directions

To Great Pond from New Hampshire border, take the Maine Turnpike north, (I-95N) to Exit 44 (signs for South Portland/I-295 North).

Continue on I-295 North until it merges with I-95 North. Continue on I-95 North to Exit 182A which is I-395 Travel I-395 to exit 6A, Route 1A South.

Turn left on to Route #46

Turn right on to Route #9 for approximately 14 miles

Turn left at the Great Pond business district sign (first left after Route 179)

Continue for 1.4 miles

Turn left on to Great Pond Road

Continue seven miles, take slight left on to Dow Pines Road.

Total mileage, approximately 217 miles

Accommodations

Maine Lodge


The lodge sleeps 11 guests and is fully furnished with two bathrooms, large kitchen with cooking utensils, dishes, linens, towels, three fieldstone fireplaces, washer & dryer, glass sunroom, deck and satellite TV. The lodge is available for small receptions, business meetings or recreational functions.

Bigelow Lodge

The lodge sleeps eight to 10 guests. It is fully furnished, with a galley kitchen, cooking utensils, dishes, bathroom with shower, large fieldstone fireplace, gas grill, lake views with access, canoe and linens.

12 Cabins and Tumbledown

Each cabin sleeps six guests, fully furnished, woodstove, bathroom with shower, TV/VCR/DVD, toaster, coffee maker, microwave, full size refrigerator and stove, cooking utensils, dishes, heat, linens, lake views and screened porch. Tumbledown has a washer and dryer.



14 RV/Campsites

Each campsite is equipped with electrical and water hook-ups, fire ring and picnic table. Sites are suitable for RV, pop-up or tent camping. Bathhouse with shower and toilet facilities located near sites. There is an on-site waste disposal station located near the campsite area.

Five Yurts

A Yurt is a unique round structure that combines the qualities of a tent in that they have canvas side walls and the stability of a quasi-cabin in that they have a wood skeleton complete with windows, a door and skylight and they are constructed on a raised wooden deck.

Four yurts are located in the campground and one is more remote. Yurts are equipped with basic furnishings, TV with DVD and VCR, microwave oven, gas grill, electricity, heat, water hook-up as well as an outdoor picnic table and fire ring. The remote yurt has an outhouse and basic furnishings.
