

Workshop schedule: Friday Evenings Starting May 12, 19 & June 2, 9 Class will run from 5 to 7 p.m.


Minimum age is 15 years old. Minors will need a parent or guardian to accompany them (parents and guardians do not need to take the class).

The objective of this workshop is to introduce the participant to using machines for woodworking in a safe and efficient manner. It is geared for the hobbyist with limited to no experience in woodworking, and is interested in learning. In this class you will be taught how to properly use the bandsaw, drill press, compound miter saw, table saw, jointer, and thickness planer (other machines may be added as time permits). With knowledge of these primary machines you will be able plan out and start creating projects made from wood.

This workshop will be taught over the course of 4 sessions, and will consist of lectures, demonstrations, and practical work. Class size is limited to 10 participants to maximize instruction with the students. Fees paid include use of the shop throughout the workshop during normal operating times so you will be able to start creating as you learn.
